

ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI PARISH STEVE WAHLMEIER SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The scholarship recipient, each year, will be determined by a five member committee. The committee has been appointed with the approval of the Parish Pastoral Council. The parish priest will automatically be a member of the Scholarship Committee along with four other appointed members.
2. Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of financial need, morals and be a participant in their church youth group:
 - 50% participation in youth group
 - 25% financial need
 - 25% character, faith community involvement (morals)
3. The amount of the scholarship will be \$500.00; one-half payable at the time of enrollment for each semester. The principal shall be left intact and the scholarship derived from the annual interest earnings.
4. The applicant must be a high school graduate planning to attend college or a college student presently attending college. Applicants may apply and receive the scholarship more than once, but preference will be given to those closest descendants of Francis and Sally Wahlmeier who would be receiving the scholarship for the first time.
5. Preference will be given as follows:
 - A. Closest descendants or relatives of Francis and Sally Wahlmeier.
 - B. Members of Norton St. Francis of Assisi Parish and New Almelo St. Joseph Parish.
6. The deadline for receiving applications is April 15. A standard application form will be available upon request. The Scholarship Committee may request a personal interview of all acceptable applicants.
7. A high school transcript must be submitted with the application and a college transcript if in college.
8. The application must be signed by both the applicant and parent or guardian. Three reference names shall also be listed and each shall fill out a recommendation form and return it to the church. The reference named only needs to fill out one recommendation form even though the applicant is applying for several scholarships.
9. The recipient of the scholarship will be announced by May 1 of each year.
