I. NATURE OF SCHOLARSHIP

Commencing with the college school term the F.O.E. Eagles Aerie and Auxiliary #3288 of Norton, Kansas are granting two (2) college scholarships of \$500.00 each per school year to a high school graduate of any PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR GRANDPARENT in good standing of the F.O.E. Aerie and/or Auxiliary of #3288. Should a qualified applicant graduate of a parent, guardian or grandparent of a Norton Aerie and/or Auxiliary member in good standing not apply then other applicants may be considered. The recipient of the scholarship may attend any college, accredited school of nursing, or accredited vocational-technical school. The scholarship will be paid in two installments of \$250.00 each, \$250.00 after enrollment of the fall semester and \$250.00 after enrollment of the spring semester.

If the recipient falls below a "C" average or decides to no longer further his or her education, an alternate recipient will be awarded the remaining scholarship money in their place. The recipient will receive a statement of award to be signed by the graduate and his or her parents, regarding refund of scholarship funds, if he or she decides to quit school after the scholarship funds have been issued.

II. TO APPLY:

Each student wishing to apply must fill out an application form available at the Eagles lodge. The completed application form must be returned by the date determined by the committee. The application will then be considered by a committee composed of the Aerie and Auxiliary scholarship committee. This selection committee may ask for personal interviews with all or any of the applicants. This selection committee shall complete its designated duties no later than the date announced by the committee.
